Welcome to Camp Nordic 2018

This will be the 2nd time Camp Nordic is arranged. First time in 2014 we enjoyed a camp in Norway and this time we will meet in Denmark. It is a camp that gathers rangers from all the Nordic countries: Finland, Norway, Sweden, Iceland and Denmark.

We are still "United" as the title from 2014 told us, because we are united as nations and in Jesus Christ. This time we will focus on what we have in Christ and what we can pass on to each other and the people around us. Come and get inspired to "Pass it on"!

Registration:

Registration is open from 1st of January. If you want the cheapest price of 750Dkr, you need to register before 1st of May. The payment shall also be registered by 1st of May.

- Camp fee includes food, T-shirt, patch and camp book.
 - Before 1st of May, 2018 Dkr 750
 - Between 1st of May and 1st of June, 2018 Dkr. 950
 - Between 1st of June and 1st of July 2014 Dkr. 950 (you will not get a T-shirt, camp book etc.)
- If you have any kind of difficulties with your registration, you can ask for support by your national office.

- Before 1st of May, we only need the number of participants. Fee will not be refunded.
 Until 1st of July, you can exchange name of participants.
- It will not be possible to register a participant after coming to the camp!
- Wood for fire and buildings: Need to be ordered before 1st of May.
- Remember to sign in the responsible person from your outpost that shall take care of: First aid, Food, Guard/Security

- Address: Omvråvej 24, 7330 Brande, Danmark
- Age of participants: Camp Nordic will be focused on children from 10 years and up.
 Every nation can decide if they want their participants to be younger or older than 10 years old.
- Allergy: People who cannot eat certain kind of food have to pick up something else in the food depot. (We will prepare for gluten/coeliaci, lactose and diabetes) If you have a child with other difficulties you have to bring extra food yourself). The outpost leader has the responsibility to look after children who are allergic.
- **First aid:** There are persons responsible for the serious Illness/trauma. Every outpost has to take care of small wounds etc. Bring first aid equipments.

- **Flag:** All nations have to bring their national flag. They will be used close to the scene, and will be hoist every day at 8 o'clock. Each nation is in charge of hoisting their flag in the morning and to take it down in the evening.
 - Every morning at 8 o'clock one nation sings their national song when we hoist the flags. On the same day the nation in charge, read a verse from the bible and lead in prayer. Total 10 minutes.
- **Food:** Every outpost has to cook their own food.
 - You are allowed to use open fire. There is no electricity available on the camp ground.
 - Every outpost has to bring a box with their name on, it will be used to pick up and bring food back to camp.
 - You have to bring cans for water.
 - There are various distances to where you bring food and water − so a wheelbarrow (or something like that will make it easier to carry back beverages to the outpost[⊕]).
- **Insurance:** You need a personal accident insurance that includes transport home in case of an emergency. Also bring your European health insurance card with you.
- Outingday: The whole camp will go to the same place and more information will come later.
- **Swimming:** There is no scheduled time for swimming. If the delegations want to go for a bath in the small lake (or the creek), the outpost leaders are responsible for their own children.
- Valuta: During camp we will use DKr. There is a ATM in sdr.Omme 7km from camp.
- Wood for fire and building: (prices will be updated later)
 - o Wood for building will cost 10-15 Dkr/pole.
 - Wood for fire will cost ??Dkr/m3 (price will come later)
 - Wood need to be ordered before 1st of May.
- Workshops: Every outpost has to have at least one workshop per day. We hope bigger outposts (20+) can have two or more. Bring material for 3 days of workshop activities. (Sunday, Tuesday, Thursday)
